

ENERGY EFFICIENCY ALBERTA – ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS

As part of the Alberta Climate Leadership Plan, through funds raised via the carbon levy, the Alberta Government has taken steps to form an organization called Energy Efficiency Alberta. Its aim is to help individuals, businesses, and other organizations to help increase their energy efficiency, reduce their carbon footprint, and ultimately reduce the amount of carbon tax they pay out. Energy Efficiency Alberta has recently announced three “starter kit” programs which will be kicked off in early 2017.

Residential Programs:

- Residential No-cost Energy Savings Program
 - Free installation of residential efficiency products such as lighting elements, water fixtures and programmable thermostats in homes and multi-unit residential dwellings across Alberta.
- Residential Products Program
 - Rebates on efficient appliances, lighting and insulation for homes.

Commercial Programs:

- Business, Non-Profit and Institutional Rebate Program
 - Incentives for high-efficiency retrofits of lighting, heating, cooling and hot water systems for businesses, non-profits, and institutions.
- Non-Profit Energy Efficiency Transition (NEET) Program
 - The NEET Program will provide funding to help non-profit and volunteer groups determine how efficient their current lighting, heating, cooling and hot water systems are. Once equipped with audit information, agencies can take advantage of the Business, Non-Profit and Institutional Rebate Program.
 - The first step for accessing this program is to complete an “Expression of Interest Form”, available on the website listed below.
