The Award

The Laura Crawford Scholarship Award was established in 2008 to honour the late Laura Crawford. Laura championed seniors housing professionals to be their best and pioneered the person-centred approach long before it was a trending buzzword. For almost 20 years Laura shared her progressive knowledge, wisdom and grit which inspired everyone to take a fresh look at what they do for individuals while maintaining a home environment. She advocated for the resident and encouraged her students to be leaders in both their professional and personal lives, using education and attitude as change agents! Laura's nursing career gave her the background to understand the physiological and psychological changes that occur in our later years, but it was her personal "no nonsense" philosophies that guided students to see seniors as adults and not dependents! In her words, "there was to be no more motherhood and apple pie"; meaning that even though the resident may need more support; you cannot take away the integrity, dignity and the functional abilities that they have. Residents should be enabled not disabled.

The Laura Crawford Scholarship Award of \$1000 is granted to one applicant every year registered in or attending the Site Manager or the Activity Coordinator Program, and is to be used within one calendar year of the award. This Scholarship Award is intended to support ongoing growth and learning offsetting a portion of the cost of ASCHA/RDC Certificate Program courses offered at Red Deer College.

Eligibility

The applicant must:

- work for an ASCHA Regular Member organization
- be committed to completing one of the ASCHA/RDC Certificate Programs
- have been employed in the seniors housing industry for a minimum of two years
- be a resident of Alberta for one year.

Selection Criteria

The selection criteria will be based on:

- evidence of professionalism through passion, warmth, commitment and a positive, supportive attitude
- ability to demonstrate a person-centred approach
- ability to lead and energize staff to encourage a creative and lively environment
- demonstrate the philosophy of formal and informal lifelong learning
- illustrate pride in working in the Seniors' Housing Industry

Application Process

The following must be submitted:

- A short cover letter that demonstrates your practice of the qualities exemplified by Laura Crawford
- Resume
- One reference letter from each of the following groups:
 - Senior Management/Leadership
 - Colleague or resident

Applications will be reviewed by the ASCHA Selection Committee. The Laura Crawford Scholarship Award recipient will be announced at the ASCHA Convention & Tradeshow.
